

# MicroMedex

## (Web Access and Mobile Downloads)

Do you need to look up a drug or disease for one of your assignments? The library has a subscription to the drug database MicroMedex for all our students.

1. Go to the Health Sciences Library's website at <http://columbiabasin.edu/hslibrary>
2. Click on the dark blue button "**Health Sciences Databases**" just above the search box.
3. A new page showing a list of databases should open. Click on "**MicroMedex**" under "M". You should be logged in directly on campus. At home, log in with your student email and password.
4. A page with two buttons should open. Click on the black Micromedex button. (The other button says "CareNotes", which contains patient handouts.)
5. You should now see the homepage as shown in the screenshot below. Use the "Keyword search" box on the left, type in a drug name, and start searching.
6. If you want to download the mobile apps to your phone for offline use, **click on the grey "Download Mobile Apps" button** on the lower right corner of the page.


